Earl Scott is the Global Fleet Support Director. In this position he led over 3,000 personnel, was responsible for managing 75 facilities and performing all aircraft sustainment engineering, logistics and air cargo operations on over 2,600 military and commercial aircraft annually.

His additional AF experience includes serving as the Maintenance Group Commander at RAF Mildenhall, England, Deputy Maintenance Group Commander at Joint Base Charleston, SC; and Deputy Director of both the Force Development & Information Systems Branch, HAF/A4, Pentagon, where he developed Air Force-wide strategic and training policy for over 150,000 logistics personnel maintaining more than 5,400 military aircraft.
